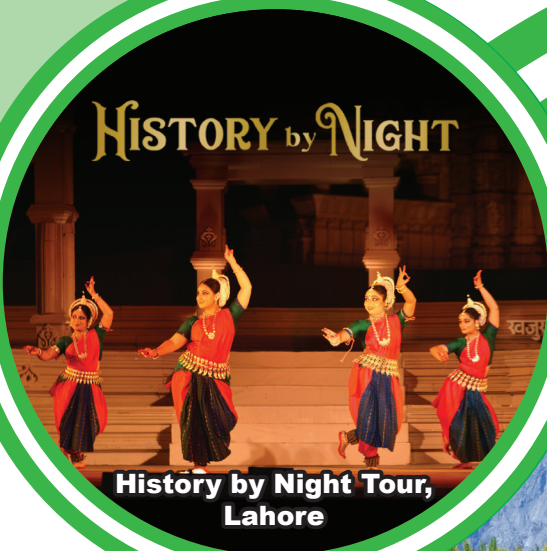

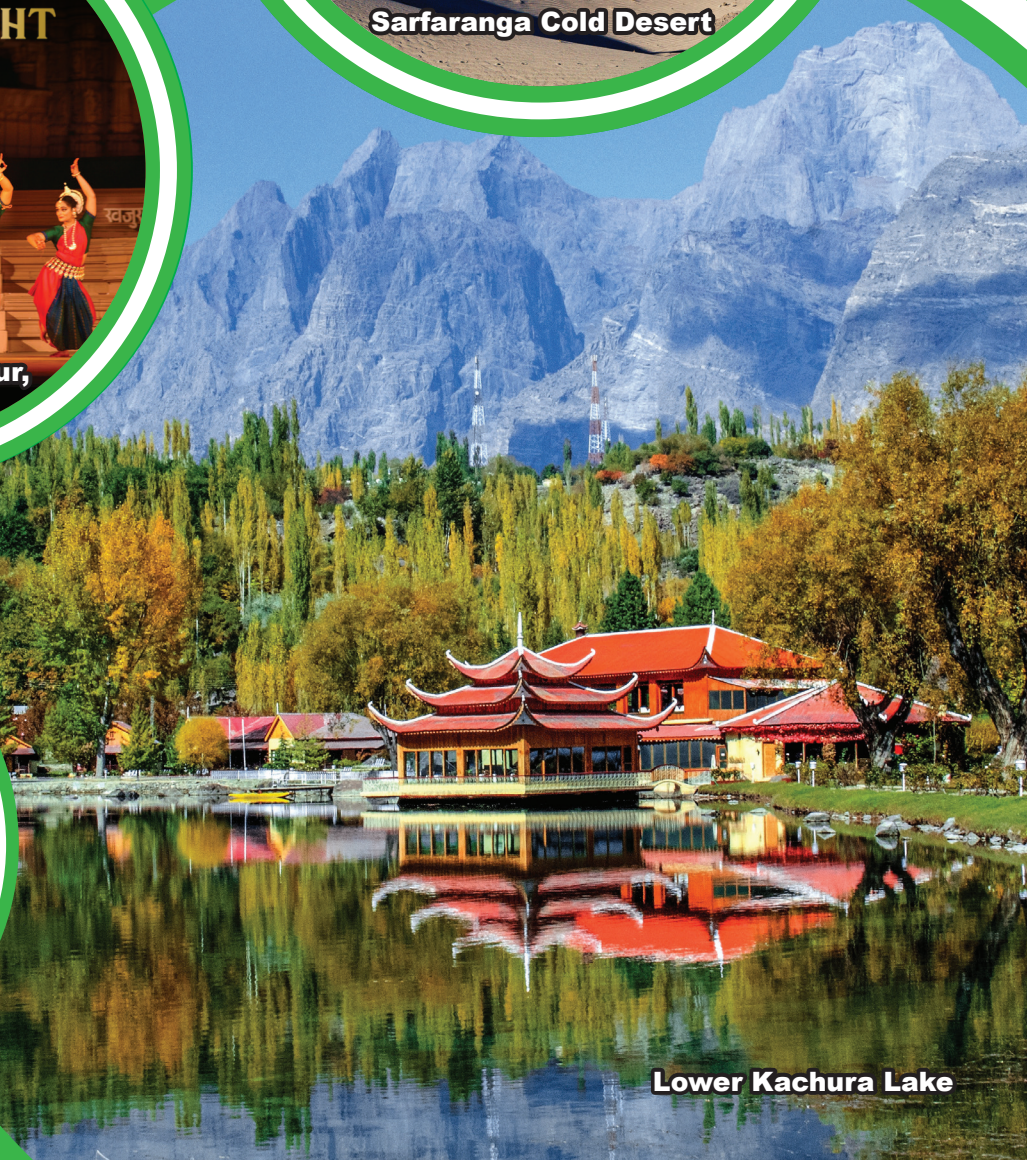

SHIGAR

- **Sarfaranga Cold Desert** - At a height of 7,500 feet, the Sarfaranga Cold Desert presents a unique landscape of sand dunes and extremely cold temperatures. Unlike typical deserts, it captivates visitors with its cool breezes and stunning sunset views.
*Best time to visit Sarfaranga Cold Desert is from June to September
- **Shigar Fort** - Means The Fort on Rock, is a fort in Skardu, Gilgit-Baltistan. It was built by the Katur dynasty and is located at the top of the Shigar Valley. The fort has many historic structures including various palaces, mosques and shrines inside it.

SKARDU

- **Manthal Buddha Rock** - A large granite rock featuring Buddha carvings dating back to the 8th century, located in Manthal Village of Skardu. It is an important cultural heritage site in Gilgit-Baltistan.
- **Kachura Lake** - There are two lakes in Kachura Valley: the lesser-known Upper Kachura Lake and the famous Shangrila Lake (Lower Kachura Lake), known for its scenic beauty and resort surroundings.
- **Katpanah Cold Desert** - Situated at an altitude of 2,226 meters, this is one of the highest cold deserts in the world, featuring vast sand dunes set against a backdrop of snow-capped mountains.

HUNZA

- **Hunza Valley** - Located at an altitude of 2,438 meters at the northern end of the Hunza River, this region is renowned for its pristine landscapes of mountains and glaciers. Surrounded by peaks over 7,000 meters such as Rakaposhi, Ultar, and Diran, Hunza Valley is divided into Upper Hunza (Gojal), Central Hunza, and Lower Hunza (Shinaki).
*The best time to experience cherry blossoms is typically from mid-March to mid-April (Depends on altitude)
- **Altit Fort** - An ancient fort perched on a cliff, once home to the rulers of Hunza, known for its unique architecture and historical significance.
- **Eagle's Nest View Point** - Located in Duiker village, this viewpoint offers panoramic sunset views over Hunza and Nagar Valleys, surrounded by peaks such as Rakaposhi, Diran, Spantik (Golden Peak), Ulter, Hunza Peak, Lady Finger and numerous other snow-capped mountains.
- **Passu Cones** - A scenic area famous for its dramatic jagged peaks, forming one of the most iconic landscapes along the Karakoram Highway.
- **Attabad Lake** - Located in Gojal Valley at an altitude of 2,559 meters, this stunning turquoise lake was formed after a natural disaster and is fed by surrounding glaciers and the Hunza River.
- **Hussaini Suspension Bridge** - One of the most thrilling suspension bridges in the world, offering a unique experience with breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains and river below.
